KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Professor Bohui Zhang is currently the Executive Dean and President's Chair Professor of the School of Economics and Management of the Chinese University of Hong Kong (Shenzhen), the Director of the Fintech and Social Finance Research Center of the Shenzhen Advanced Institute of Finance, and the Deputy Dean of the Shenzhen Institute of Data Economics. Professor Zhang engages in diverse research areas, including fintech, media. China's capital markets. and international capital markets. His research findings have been repeatedly published in leading academic journals, including

Review of Financial Studies, Journal of Financial Economics, Journal of Accounting Research, Management Science, Journal of Financial Quantitative and Analysis, Journal of International Business Studies, Review of Finance, etc. Professor Zhang has served as a reviewer for more than 30 international academic journals, including *Journal of Finance*, Review of Financial Studies, Journal of Accounting Research, Accounting Review, Management Science.

Professor Xiong Xiong holds the position of Professor at the School of Management and Economics, Tianjin University, serving as a doctoral supervisor and deputy director. His primary research focuses on big data finance, computational experimental finance, enterprise development, and financial strategy. He currently holds multiple esteemed positions, including director of the Financial Systems Engineering Technical Committee, vice chairman of the Decision-Making Branch of the Chinese Operations Research Society, and vice chairman of the Quantitative Finance and Insurance Branch of



the Chinese Society of Optimization, Overall Planning and Economic Mathematics. Professor Xiong has published over 80 academic papers and authored two monographs. He serves as the principal investigator for over 10 national and provincial-level projects, including major project of the National Natural Science Foundation. He has been awarded a series of honors, including the Ministry of Education's "New Century Excellent Talents Support Program" and the Tianjin Youth Science and Technology Award.





Professor Donghui Li is a Distinguished Professor of Accounting and Finance at the College of Economics, Shenzhen University. His research focuses on accounting and corporate finance. His papers have been published in top-tier finance journals worldwide, including Journal of Finance, Journal of Financial and Quantitative Analysis, Journal of International Business Studies, and other renowned finance journals, including: Journal of Corporate Finance (six times), Journal of Banking and Finance (five times), Journal of

International Money and Finance (two times), Journal of Risk and Insurance (two times), Journal of Business Finance & Accounting (two times), amongst many others. He has also published many articles in leading Chinese journals, including: Economic Research (two times), Management World, and so on.
